

Luma Hotel to Open in Times Square

Luma Hotel Times Square is set to open this fall on 41st Street in Manhattan's Times Square. Designed by local architect Peter Poon, the all-glass curtain wall façade illuminates the space between two prewar buildings.



Channeling an illumination theme, the property's ground-floor lobby is designed by San Francisco and New York-based CCS Architecture. The 130 neutral-toned guestrooms and suites feature floor-to-ceiling windows, and chef Jose Garces will introduce the Basque-inspired Ortzi restaurant and bar with ample café-style seating.
